**Speaker: Brigadier Jim Wallace AM (rtd)**

*Jim had a 33 year Army career which included command of the SAS Regt, the Special Forces and the Army's mechanised brigade, the 1st Brigade. In 1980 he served with the United Nations Treaty Supervision Organisation on the Golan Heights and in Lebanon.*

*He was both a student and then lecturer at the British Army Staff College.*

*In 1984 he was made a Member of the Order of Australia for his command of the SAS counter terrorism squadron.*

*In 2002 he left the Army to join the Australian Christian Coalition from which he formed the Australian Christian Lobby and then the Lachlan Macquarie Institute which motto is to train "Wise Leaders", and the Christian legal firm the Human Rights Law Alliance.*

*During this time he was also a Government appointee to both the Council of the Australian Strategic Policy Institute and the National Committee for International Security Issues. He is currently the Chairman of the Australian Christian Lobby, and on the boards of LMI and HRLA.*
